



Upgrading of an existing abattoir into an export accredited red meat abattoir with an eventual slaughter capacity of 40 bovine units per day. Project also entails the development of a new meat processing / value addition plant catering for a range of processed meat products. Currently plant process is amended to suit specific Meatco (commodity trade) operational requirements.

Project includes abattoir and meat processing buildings, a truck wash bay, larynges and cattle ramps, internal streets and parking areas on the abattoir site, site sewer and water reticulation networks, effluent dams.
