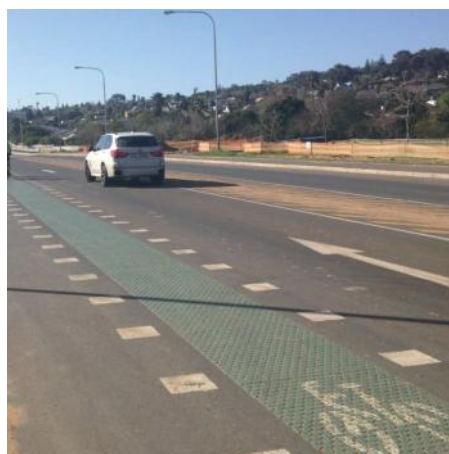
Objectives of the project:
